- 1. 100% of single-person entries must be completed by the entrant: This includes the construction of quilt top, the quilting, and the binding.
- 2. If entrant has won Junior Best of Show twice, then entrant must enter show as an adult amateur.
- 3. Junior quilts may be quilted by an adult, but are not eligible for the Junior Best of Show award.

The Best of Show winner in the Junior Category will receive \$350. We are very fortunate to have private donors to help sponsor the prizes for this category.
