Supply List

8 – 10 silk neckties (Other silks from scarves, recycled clothing or yardage are also suitable. Avoid super sheer silk chiffon.)

¼ yard of plain or contrasting fabric for the background of the Flying Geese

2 yards of lightweight fusible interfacing (Pellon P44F, 906F, SF101 or Quilters Select Fabric Pep)

¼ yard plain lightweight cotton muslin (Prewashed if possible)

Prework

To prepare for this workshop, these two videos show you how to deconstruct ties and add fusible interfacing before class.

General sewing supplies

Sewing machine in good working order, foot control, power cord, needles 70/10 & 80/12,
bobbins

Regular presser foot or walking foot

Thread in neutral color

Scissors, thread snips and seam ripper

Rotary cutter with good blade, cutting mat and ruler

Pins

Notebook/sketchbook and pen/pencil
