Use any materials you choose, any colors, just incorporate the theme. Viewer's choice and prizes will be awarded.

Guidelines:

- Quilts must be less than 120" perimeter
- Any technique or embellishments are acceptable
- Quilt must consist of three layers and be finished on all edges
- Theme must be incorporated in the quilt
- No identifying information should be displayed on the front of the quilt

Bitty Blocks With Char Montgomery

Fabric: Bring your scraps. Lots of scraps. Maybe enough to share with others, for a larger variety. Big and small. Some of the pieces are 1 inch. You can also bring fat quarters and a sizeable amount of neutrals or lighter background fabric. If you want to use all one background, I would guess you need about 5-6 yards of it. The main thing is high contrast so you can see the block from a distance.

Standard Sewing supplies like your machine, cord, pedal and thread.

Small cutting mat and rotary cutter to have at your side. You don't want to be standing at the cutting table all day.

A square ruler. Any size you already have will work, but you will appreciate a 3 ½ and/or 4 ½ square up ruler. It's not necessary to go out and buy one if you don't already have one.

A yard of freezer paper for the paper pieced row. Or you can print your own from the quiltmaker.com website under the tab bitty blocks. It's the bitty trees that are paper pieced. A postcard or heavy cardstock for this block too.

If you want to get started early, you can download the bitty block patterns from quiltmaker.com. There is a Bitty Blocks tab on the home page. You can precut some of your fabric, view the patterns or wait till you get to the retreat. Looking forward to showing you how fun these blocks are.

Directions to Ceta Canyon Retreat

From Amarillo (North)

Take I-27 south to exit #94 toward Wayside. Go east (left) on FM 285 for 8 miles until you see signs for the camp. Go north 2.5 miles into the camp. (Office is across from the mailboxes)

From Lubbock (South)

Take I-27 north to exit #94 toward Wayside. Go east (right) on FM 285 for 8 miles until you see signs for the camp. Go north 2.5 miles into the camp. (Office is across from the mailboxes)

From Vernon (East)

From US-287 take US-86 west. Follow the signs to TX-207 and head North. Go west on FM 285 past Wayside until you see signs for the camp. Go north on FM 1721 2.5 miles into the camp. (Office is across from the mailboxes)
