## Guest Teacher



Vicki Conley has been a professional artist working in ceramics for over 42 years and owns a gallery, Piñon Pottery, in Ruidoso Downs, New Mexico. She discovered quilting in 2004 and quickly began designing her own art quilts exploring color, form and texture utilizing myriad modern techniques. Vicki loves trying new techniques and materials, and usually explores themes in the natural world using her own photographs as inspiration.

### What to Expect

You will learn how to simply and combine photos into a graphic design both the old fashioned way with tracing paper and with apps on the iPad. You will learn Vicki's turned edge machine piecing technique using Floriani Stitch n Wash stabilizer. Cutting apart the stabilizer to use as templates, you will see how easy it is to turn the edges with glue stick. It is left in the finished piece giving nice body to the art quilt. You will also learn her fussy piecing technique using a gradation fabric. You can construct either a landscape or an animal.

Each student is responsible for their own meals, as well as their own hotel/overnight accommodations.

- Lesson in appliquéing with Floriani Stitch n Wash stabilizer
- Working your own photos into a design and enlarging pattern.
- Fabric selection and using string piecing to enhance areas of your design.

Friday, July 22<sup>nd</sup>

9 AM – 5 PM

- Lesson on fussy piecing with gradation fabric on Floriani stabilizer.
- Continue working on your own piece.

Please bring a variety of inspiration photos of the same place. It usually makes a good design to combine elements from more than one image rather than just copying an image outright. ## Supply List: Designing from Photo to Imagination

A selection of photos printed out 8.5 x 11

IPad or other tablet (optional) with photos on it.

Sketch book – no lines

Pencil with eraser and Black Sharpie

Tracing paper and Scotch tape

Parchment paper or applique pressing sheet

Iron /iron surface

Small mat and rotary cutter and ruler

Scissors - fabric and paper

Colored pencils – **NOT** water soluble

Elmer's washable glue stick disappearing purple (small)

Portable design wall like 30 x 20 foam core board from Hobby Lobby.

Light box- this one is a great value.

Sewing Machine with zigzag stitch (If you want to bring a Featherweight you can do the zig zag stitching when you get home)

Small sewing machine needles Microtex sharp 60/8 or 70/10 recommended for invisible zigzag, and average piecing needle

Seam ripper

Apliquick Tools or Stiletto

Piecing thread - neutral grey cotton.

Invisible thread – mono poly –**NOT** nylon

13 x 13inch piece of black fabric.

Scraps various light medium dark. Small pieces for mini collage

Various fabrics for a landscape – lights mediums and darks. Gradation and ombre fabrics work best.

About 1 yard of gradation blue fabric for the sky. Here is a link to gradation blue ombre fabric if you want to order some. <https://www.aquiltingstitchuation.shop/shop/c/p/2046-50-Essential-Gradations-UltraBlue-Ombre-x62275722.htm>

Floriani Stitch N Wash fusible water soluble tearaway stabilizer – available for purchase from the teacher. (\$3.50/yard)

A few bucks to cover enlarging and printing your pattern. I will bring a printer to print the patterns. In the event that doesn't work out we will need to go to a copy shop to resize and print.
