Workshops

Do you have a Featherweight?

Rosemary Russell will be showing how to oil and clean this great little machine to extend it already long-life! Bring your Featherweight and get some hands-on experience.

Dyeing with Food! What do mashed potatoes, oatmeal, Karo syrup, tapioca, rock salt, pasta and hair gel have in common? Kathy Hassell will show how these products can create interesting texture on fabric when used with dye. Bring 24 white cotton fabrics cut into 12 1/2" squares. The weight of the fabric is not important and does not have to be prepared for dyeing. Bring an apron or old shirt to protect your clothing.

Ink-liqué. Don't cut and fuse those little pieces on your blocks – just fill it in with ink! Tamra René will show this simple way to create something different. Quilt your design on white fabric and then use markers or gel pens for color and interest. Everything will be provided.

From Amarillo (North)

Take I-27 S to Lubbock

In Lubbock, take Exit 1B toward US-84/TX-289 Loop E/Post

Continue on US-84 for 69.8 Miles

Turn left on to County Rd 2121 and follow the signs to Wooden Spoke Ranch

From Midland

Take I-20 E Toward Snyder

Take Exit 178 toward TX-350 N for approximately 47 miles go through Snyder

Turn left onto US-84 W for another 7.4 miles

Turn Right onto County Rd 2105 for 1.4 miles

Turn left onto Country Rd 2128 and follow signs to Wooden Spoke Ranch

From Abilene

Take I-20 W/US-84 W for about 40 miles

Take Exit 238A to merge onto US-84 W toward Snyder/Lubbock

Go about 41 miles and turn right onto County Road 1142

Turn left only County Road 2128
